### Focus of Meeting – The role of the Safety Ambassador

#### 1. Bullying Prevention

- a. All ambassadors shared what their classes did for Anti-Bullying Week 2023
  - o Ambassadors helped in Whole School Assembly to Make a Noise About Bullying
    - o Watched videos about preventing bullying
    - $\circ$  Wore off socks to remind others about looking out for bullying
    - o Making posters
    - o Sharing the school Bullying Prevention Policy for Children
    - o Making helping hands
    - o Creating Helping Bees
- b. Ambassadors went to visit other classrooms to collect photos of their displays

### 2. Safety at Christmas

- a. Safety Ambassadors watched a video about being safe at Christmas from the Fire Service
- b. They listed potential risks and ideas to make sure children are safe
- c. These were put into a poster and shared with classes

### 3. Children's Voice about Safety in School

- a. All the children who are Safety Ambassadors said they still felt safe at school
- b. Mrs Walsh asked what AECPS does to keep them safe:
  - o Shut gates and fences to keep people out and children in
  - o Make sure the classrooms and hall are clean
  - o Teachers sort out arguments quickly between children
  - o We have first aiders
  - o We practice fire alarms
  - o Children do work on bullying prevention
  - o We have lessons on how to keep safe on the computers



# To be even safer the Ambassadors suggested:

- Putting up security cameras
- Put down more grit in some areas of the playground
- o Remind children to not use quiet area as a base and run around
- o Suggest the children in the ball pen move out if they are not playing the game

### Action for Ambassadors for next meeting

- Share minutes from meeting
- Run a class assembly on ways to stay safe at Christmas using the AECPS Christmas Safety Poster
- Share the Bullying Prevention PowerPoint to remind children of what they have done and what they know
