Focus of Meeting - Anti Bullying and Safeguarding

1) Welcome

2) Safeguarding

Councillors to announce Anti Bullying Week Starting on Monday 11^{th} November 2019 Councillors to collect ideas for each class to do on the theme during Anti Bullying Week for additional meeting on 24^{th} Oct 2019

3) Voice of the School

Councillors to hold class council to identify two things that have gone well this term and one thing the children could do better. Link to the children's school aims on the school website on Keeping Children Safe, Inclusion and Behaviour

Action: Councillors canvass opinion in class council and revisit school aims with class

4) Anti-Bullying Policy

Mrs Walsh needs to revisit the school policy on Anti Bullying with all the different partners in school including staff, children, governors and parents

Children need to input into this policy

Mrs Walsh shared examples of child friendly policies on Anti Bullying

During Anti Bullying week each class will hold a class council to consider main headings decide what they think should be in the details of the content

School council will then draft their own version using ideas of all the classes to share with the children and form the basis of the school policy



Action: Councillors to look at the shared policies and make a list of important subheadings that should be in our policy by next meeting
