
PTA Playground Project

The PTA is a charity run group made up of parents and teachers that donate their time and effort into improving the lives of those at Alderley Edge Primary school however big or small.

The project of the last PTA, the MUGA (multi-use games area) is being built right now on the field, and was a huge effort of years of fundraising by everyone involved.

The new PTA group has been asked to turn their attentions into raising money to update the school playground areas. There is remedial work to do, painting, and designing areas of the playground to promote imagination through play. Playgrounds offer children the chance to play and learn about the world around them, experience challenge and develop social, emotional, physical and creative skills through independent, openended and unpredictable play in a space that is free from risk.

We'd love your help to fulfil our plans for the playgrounds.



The playground spaces are numerous and large, therefore our focus first is on the top playground.

Remedial work is required on the stage area that is rotting, the maze, the uneven surface in the quiet area, the climbing wall, and a roof for the lean to.



After that, we'll focus on raising money for some fun thermoplastic markings. The school will look for a grant to improve the red line markings and we will look to add designated areas for play.

Following that, our imagination can run wild on what else we can add. We are limited to having items that are hard-wearing and are useable all year round, so wooden structure that damage and rot with wear and weather are less preferred.

All these things will take time and money, so we'd appreciate you'd support in all the events that the PTA put on, whether it's cake sales, discos, summer fairs or quiz nights. ALL of the money raised goes directly into our playground fund.
