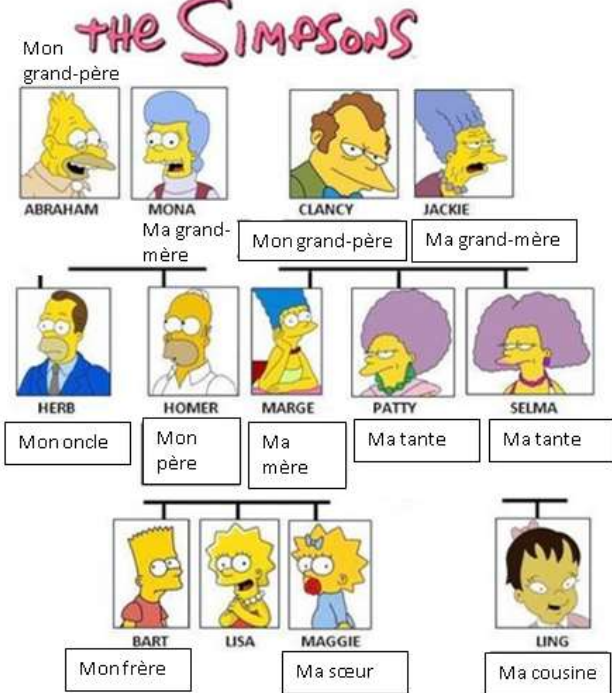

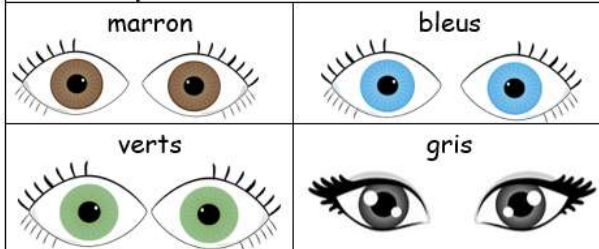

Brother, Mother and Father all rhyme in French (frère, mère, père) The adjective is placed after the noun in a French sentence.</p>
