- To use 2 key verbs in first person present tense (joue and fais)
- To use **a + definite article** for sports you play (jouer)
- To use **de + definite article** for sports you do (faire)
- To adapt phrases to create new sentences about sports they play or do

Le - the (masculine)

de + le = du e.g. je fais du vélo

de + la = de la e.g. je fais de la voile
